*For scores to be eligible for members, for Team selection they must be shot at a QAPSA/PA sanctioned event.*

Prior to putting any person through the Holster Accreditation Course check that the person has a Category H licence and is affiliated with QAPSA/ Pistol Australia.

### REMEMBER QAPSA LTD SANCTIONED SHOTS ARE FOR QAPSA AFFILIATED MEMBERS ONLY.

CARRY YOUR QAPSA AFFILIATION CARD WITH YOU AT ALL QAPSA SANCTIONED EVENTS, ALONG WITH YOUR PA HOLSTER PROFICIENCY CARD IF SHOOTING SERVICE PISTOL, INTERNATIONAL 1920 MATCH OR WA 1500

**ALSO A MUST: YOUR CATEGORY H LICENCE OR MINORS LICENCE: IT IS A LEGAL REQUIREMENT THAT YOUR CATEGORY H LICENCE IS CHECKED BY THE RANGE OFFICER PRIOR TO SHOOTING.**

### COMMITTEES OF MANAGEMENT REMEMBER ....

It is a WLB requirement that all non - licence holders sign a Form 33 (or Form 33A if regulars) prior to shooting.  
Before commencing shooting at any event the club should sight:

1. Form 33 or 33A (+ **ID**) completed; or
2. Qld Firearms, Category H, Minors or interstate Concealable Licence.
3. PA Holster Proficiency Card (if competing in PA Holster events); or other associations' holster proficiency cards if shooting other associations' events.
4. If it is a QAPSA sanctioned event a QAPSA/Pistol Australia membership card must be sighted also.
5. A Form 33 can only be used by a non-licensed person - a licensed pistol shooter who has forgotten their licence cannot use a Form 33 or 33A
6. Persons signing a Form 33 or 33A must also sign the Range Register.
7. A Form 33 can now be used by unlicensed interstate participants.

**Numbers 1, 2, 5, 6 & 7 are all according to the Weapons Act and Regulations.**

## METALLIC SILHOUETTE NATIONALS SMALL BORE & FIELD PISTOL

The fourteenth National Championships in the Small Bore and Field Pistol events was conducted at the Bowral Pistol Club Range from the 5<sup>th</sup> to 7<sup>th</sup> March. There were shooters and teams from New South Wales, ACT, Victoria, Tasmania and Queensland. Competitors were assured of strong competition with the complete Australian team in attendance.

Conditions over the three days ranged from fog and rain to bright sunshine. The rapidly changing weather made maintaining a constant sight picture very difficult and it was the luck of the draw as to whether you had good or bad conditions.

Queensland was represented by long time team members John and Judy Harding together with newbie Kellie Coleman from Toogoolawah Pistol Club. Judy was somewhat disadvantaged having had a recent double knee replacement which made shooting from the creedmore position impossible with some of the pistols she would normally use. This required a change to the prone shooting position and some scores were below normal.

Our new team member, Kellie, rose to the challenge and shot PB's in two of the six events as well as PB's in the Small Bore 4 Match Aggregate and Field Pistol 2 Match Aggregate. Judy also shot a PB in Small Bore Standing giving her the silver medal and was successful in winning both the Ladies Small Bore 4 Match Aggregate and the Field Pistol 2 Match Aggregate. Kellie and Judy went on to win the Field Pistol Ladies Team event and placed second in the Small Bore Ladies Team event. All team members had placings in the Top Ten in numerous events.

QAPSA Ltd is linked to Sports Connect through AISL and has signed the Sports CONNECT Charter to commit our association to connection and inclusion of disabled athletes to the sport of Pistol Shooting.

If you have disabled athletes in your club who wish to participate in future Talent Search Programs or just wish to find out a little more, contact QAPSA Office.

***What do I have to do to shoot a good accurate shot?***

You have to align the sights correctly in the aiming area, which will make the shot impact in the centre of the target and then cause the pistol to fire without mis-aligning the sights.

The basics, stance, grip, sight alignment, breath control and trigger control and follow through are learnt and practised so as to develop the ability to complete the “two” requirements of a good shot.

**Stance:**

As everybody is different, ie. height, weight, strength etc. it is obvious there is no special stance that suits everybody. Each person must develop their own stance, which will fulfill the requirements of shooting a good shot.

The main requirements of stance are:

1. To position your head as level as possible, so as to maintain your normal visual horizon. If the head is tilted then the neck muscles will be under tension. This can cause unintentional head movement during shooting and is disastrous for good sighting. The eye should be in a position to see the target in line with your arm and sights (this means that your stance has a great deal to do with your pistol/grip combination). The first part to determine is how to stand and have the eye aligned with the sights and then position yourself to align with the target.

2. To be able to hold the pistol in the shooting position with the least amount of muscle strain and the most amount of stability. The basic angle of the body in relation to the shooting arm will be arrived at by the requirements of number 1 above. The distance the feet are apart is up to you, but you need maximum stability with minimum muscle strain. The best starting position is shoulder width apart. If the feet are placed closer together then stability is compromised, as they are spread further apart, muscle strain comes into play.

The body should have a slight lean backwards to compensate for the forward movement of the centre of gravity caused by the extended arm and pistol. The non-shooting arm should be in a pocket, or anchored in some way, not just hanging loose in the breeze.

Many “good” shooters have developed their stance over a period of time and now it is automatic to them. The *really* “good” shooters will often revisit their stance to see if there is any way of improving it.

The moral is: if you are trying to develop a stance, do not do what somebody else is doing, ask questions, discuss it with other shooters and develop your own.
