A HISTORY LESSON: THE ORIGINS OF PISTOL SHOOTING IN AUSTRALIA

(Borrowed from the Pistol Australia website and the PA Bulletin 50th Anniversary issue)

- Pistol shooting started at State level with structured competitions in Tasmania (1931) and SA (1933)
- The South Australia Pistol & Revolver Assn was the only organisation representing the sport prior to the 1956 Olympics
- Pistol Australia (known as APSUA: Amateur Pistol Shooting Union of Australia) was established on 16 June 1956, just before the 1956 Olympic Games in Melbourne.
- The foundation of this national body enabled the Australian Olympic Committee to field the first target pistol shooting team to represent Australia at these Olympics.
- Preparations for the 1956 Olympics led to pistol shooting legislation around Australia being relaxed to enable training and selection of target pistol shooters to represent Australia. The existence of Category H licences is due to this relaxation of regulations.
- Additional state pistol associations were formed along with APSUA for the specific purpose of enabling the entry of an Australian Target Pistol Shooting team to compete at the '56 Games.
- In 1956 there were only 3 matches: Free Pistol (now 50m Pistol), Rapid Fire and Centre Fire.
- After the 1956 Olympics APSUA set out to gain better conditions for all target pistol shooters in Australia: APSUA negotiated with the Dept of Trade on the basis that the 'ability of Australia to produce shooters of international standards depended on the availability of good class

equipment'.

- The Dept of Trade then agreed 'to view with sympathy applications for import licences endorsed by the Union'.

Thus started the import of firearms and the evolution of our sport to what it is today.

When the matches were introduced by APSUA into Australian pistol shooting:

- 1958: First APSUA Nationals: Free Pistol, Rapid Fire, Centre Fire
- 1963: First International Mayleigh Cup
- 1964: Ladies Match (now 25m Pistol)
- 1968: Standard Pistol
- 1970: 40 shot Air Pistol (men & women combined)
- 1976: Service Pistol
- 1977: 1st Service Nationals (service and civilian divisions)
- 1977: Black Powder
- 1979: 50m Black Powder
- 1979: 40 shot Air Pistol split into men and womens events
- 1982: Air Pistol for men became 60 shots
- 1982: Metallic Silhouette, first APSUA Nationals 1987
- 1989: APSUA affiliation with NRA First Action Match Nationals (now International 1920 Match)
- 1989: Service Pistol became a power factor & holster event.
- 1991: APSUA became Pistol Australia
- 2003: 25 Yard Service
- 2004: PA affiliated with the World Association 1500 (WA 1500)
- 2006: National Champs WA 1500

Pistol Australia, through its affiliation with AISL, has the **sole** right to field target pistol shooting teams to officially represent Australia at Commonwealth & Olympic Games, ISSF World Cups, NRA Bianchi Cup and NRA World Action Champs, IMSSU Metallic Silhouette World Cup and World Association 1500 Championships.
